

Wild Rice Watershed District  
Complaints and Violations

The requirements for a permit from the Board of Managers for certain uses of water or works within the District is not intended to delay or inhibit development. Rather, permits are needed so that the Managers are kept informed of planned projects, can advise and in some instances provide assistance, and to insure that development of the natural resources is orderly and in accordance with the District's watershed management plan.

To determine if a permit has been issued for a project, access our data information portal by visiting [www.wildricewatershed.org](http://www.wildricewatershed.org) and clicking "WRWD Access Point" on the home screen. If you need assistance in accessing the online data information portal or do not have internet access, contact Kari or Tara at the District Office – 218-784-5501.

If a permit has not been issued for work, an investigation will be initiated after a complaint has been filed with the District Office. If a violation of District Rules has occurred, the party responsible can be held liable for all expenses incurred from an investigation, in addition to all costs associated with restoring the area to its original state.
