REGULAR MEETING May 10, 2017 APPROVED MINUTES

- 1. The regular meeting of the Wild Rice Watershed District Board of Managers was held on Wednesday, May 10, 2017. Managers in attendance included: Greg Holmvik, Duane Erickson, Dean Spaeth, Sharon Askelson, Mike Christensen and Raymond Hanson. Manager Curt Johannsen was absent. In addition, the following persons were in attendance: Administrator Kevin Ruud, Engineer Jerry Bents, Attorney Elroy Hanson, Tara Jensen, and various other interested taxpayers and landowners.
- 2. Chairman Holmvik called the meeting to order 8:30 a.m.
- 3. <u>Agenda Approval</u>. A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Erickson to approve the meeting agenda with the following additions. Carried.
 - JD 51 Pay Request
 - Finance Committee Meeting
 - Ten Year Plan/One Watershed One Plan Update
- 4. <u>Meeting Minutes</u>. A motion was made by Manager Christensen and seconded by Manager Erickson to approve the April 12, 2017, meeting minutes as presented. Carried.
- 5. <u>Approval of Billings</u>. A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Hanson to approve the payment of billings as presented with the addition of two late bills one from Renae Kappes for office cleaning and the other from Justin Clasen for Audit preparation. Carried.
- 6. <u>Financial Report</u>. A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Hanson to approve the monthly financial report dated April 30, 2017. Carried.
- 7. Open Mic. No one spoke at this time.
- 8. <u>Audit Report Christopher Clasen, CPA</u>. Christopher Clasen, CPA from Justin Clasen & Company was in attendance and reported on the recently completed annual District audit. Clasen summarized the Communication Letter noting that the audit did not find significant deficiencies with the District, stating that the audit went very well.
- 9. <u>JD 51 Pay Request</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to approve a pay request in the amount of \$5,411.71 from Tim Crompton Excavating for work completed on the JD 51 cleanout Northwest of the City of Ada. Carried.
- 10. <u>Community Flood Protection</u>. Engineer Bents reported that he is working with Attorney Hanson to complete the final necessary acquisition for the City of Halstad certification process. He added that the land has been transferred to the cities of Hendrum and Perley and we are working to reserve maintenance easements on each of the projects.

- 11. <u>RCPP Projects</u>. Administrator Ruud stated that Public Scoping meetings for both Moccasin Creek and South Branch will be held on June 12. A meeting to further discuss the Green Meadow BCA will be held in the future as well. Chairman Holmvik added that project teams for all of the RCPP projects will be determined during the Board Reorganization later in the meeting.
- 12. <u>Lower Wild Rice</u>. Administrator Ruud informed the Board that a table of various options was put together and will be presented to BSWR and DNR representatives.
- 13. <u>Rules Update</u>. Administrator Ruud reported that the required information was published in the official paper for each of the counties that the District is in and all required transportation parties were notified of the update. A public hearing is scheduled for 10:00 am on Wednesday, June 14, 2017.
- 14. <u>JD 51 408 Submittal</u>. Attorney Hanson is continuing to work with the City of Ada to determine responsibility for potential costs due to the cadmium findings.
- 15. <u>Annual Report</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to approve the 2016 District Annual Report as presented at the April meeting. Carried.
- 16. <u>Finance Committee Meeting</u>. A finance committee meeting for the purpose of discussing annual ditch and general administration levees will be held immediately following the June Board Meeting.
- 17. <u>Ten Year Plan/One Watershed One Plan Update</u>. At the request of the Board, Administrator Ruud will invite Brett Arne, BWSR, to attend an upcoming meeting to discuss the One Watershed One Plan process.

PERMIT APPLICATIONS

- 18. <u>Clyde Neset, Section 6, Fossum Twp</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Askelson to table Permit # 17-052 to install a field crossing and culvert pending the WRWD consultants completing a survey profile of the existing ditch from the stock pond on the Neset property to the upstream end of the Kraft property. Carried.
- 19. <u>Daryl Chisholm, Section 27, Strand Twp</u>. Chisholm appealed the Board's April decision to deny the permit application. A motion was made by Manager Erickson to approve Permit #17-032 to lower a driveway culvert and regrade the roadway ditch to drain south. Motion failed due to lack of second. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to deny Permit #17-032 to lower a driveway culvert and regrade the roadway ditch to drain south. Motion carried with Manager Erickson opposed.
- 20. <u>Mark Chisholm, Section 28, Strand Twp</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Christensen to approve Permit #17-056 to remove a centerline culvert, install a culvert in a field approach and regrade roadway ditches. Carried.
- 21. <u>Petition to Drain into Project 12 Daryl Chisholm</u> A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Askelson to approve a Petition to Drain into Project 12 filed by Chisholm, noting that Chisholm will be required to pay the determined outlet fee and any accompanying administrative and engineering costs associated with the Petition. Attorney Hanson will draft the Order for Petition to file with the County Auditor/Treasurer's office. Carried.
- 22. <u>Petition to Drain into Project 34 Bill Stalboerger</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to approve a Petition to Drain into Project 34 filed by Stalboerger, noting that Stalboerger

will be required to pay the determined outlet fee and any accompanying administrative and engineering costs associated with the Petition. Attorney Hanson will draft the Order for Petition to file with the County Auditor/Treasurer's office. Carried.

- 23. <u>Mahnomen County Highway Department, County Road 5 Cost Share Request Jon Large</u>. Jon Large, Mahnomen County Engineer was in attendance and asked the Board for funding assistance to install road protection along Mahnomen County Highway 5 where the Wild Rice River is encroaching the side of the road. A motion was made by Manager Hanson on seconded by Manager Askelson to approve funding assistance of 50% up to a maximum of \$25,000 for necessary repairs. Carried.
- 24. A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Erickson to approve the following permit applications. Carried.
 - Norman County Highway Department, Various Sections, Sundal Twp. Permit #17-054 to construct a mill and overlay project.
 - Norman County Highway Department, Various Sections, Anthony and Good Hope Twps. Permit #17-053 to construct a mill and overlay project.
- 25. <u>Charles Hilde, Section 33, Rockwell Twp</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Christensen to approve Permit #17-059 to install a field access with a culvert with the condition that the pipe be no larger than 18" and up to 40 feet in length. Carried.
- 26. A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Askelson to approve the following permit applications with conditions as listed. Carried.
 - Arvig Enterprises, Many Sections, Many Twps. Permit #17-065 to bury fiber optic cable in the roadway right-of-way at many locations in Norman County with the condition that the utility line is installed a minimum of 30" below any ditch channel bottoms, the applicant is responsible for adequate erosion control measures during construction, and if a Watershed District project or other legal ditch project is hereafter initiated, repaired, or improved over permitted utility, the owner of said utility shall be responsible for the cost of moving or deepening the utility if the Watershed District deems it necessary for the construction of the repair, improvement or initiation of the project.

A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to table Permit #17-036 to install subsurface drain tile pending applicant supply a revised application or documentation that Kreblitz opposition is addressed. Carried.
- 33. <u>Duane Erickson, Sections 22 & 23, Walworth Twp.</u> A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Hanson to table Permit #17-037 to install a centerline culvert, install a section of drain tile in the roadway ditch, and construct a dry block field approach at the request of the applicant to allow him time to work with the township and come back with an amended permit application. Carried.

Carried.
- 39. <u>Bill Stalboerger</u>, Section 26, Popple Grove Twp. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to approve Permit #17-012 to install subsurface drain tile with the condition that the applicant meet all requirements set as part of the WRWD order to allow to use Project No. 34 Mahnomen County Ditch No 3, Lateral B as an outlet under 103E.401 and also with standard tile conditions. Carried.
- 40. <u>Nathan Sweep, Section 23, Beaulieu Twp</u>. A motion was made by Manager Spaeth and seconded by Manager Hanson to approve Permit #17-050 to install a water and sediment control basin project with standard tile conditions. Carried.
- 41. <u>Vig Farms, Section 2, Gregory Twp</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Christensen to approve Permit #17-064 to install a water and sediment control basin project with standard tile conditions. Carried.
- 42. <u>Board Reorganization</u>. Chairman Holmvik asked Attorney Hanson to preside over Board Officer Reorganization. Attorney Hanson called for nominations for Chairman. Raymond Hanson nominated Greg Holmvik for the position of Chairman. Holmvik was unanimously appointed Chairman. Attorney Hanson called for nominations for Vice-Chairman. Holmvik nominated Michael Christensen for the position of Vice-Chairman. Christensen was unanimously appointed Vice-Chairman. Attorney Hanson called for nominations for Secretary. Dean Spaeth nominated Sharon Askelson for the position of Secretary. Askelson was unanimously appointed Secretary. Attorney Hanson called for nominations for the position of Treasurer. Askelson nominated Spaeth for the position of Treasurer. Spaeth was unanimously appointed Treasurer. At this time Attorney Hanson returned the meeting to Chairman Holmvik's lead.
- 43. <u>Committee Assignments</u>. Committee and representative assignments were made as detailed in Appendix A at the end of this report.
- 44. <u>Interested Parties for Ring Dike Program</u>. Applications were received from John Germolus, for a ring dike improvement, and Sheena Moore for a new ring dike on the former Carlsrud site. Two other parties have expressed interested in the Ring Dike Program but have not submitted applications.
- 45. <u>South Branch Repair</u> A motion was made by Manager Erickson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to table repairs to the South Branch pending the findings from the South Branch RCPP process. Carried.
- 46. <u>Per Diems</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Spaeth to approve payment of Manager per diems and expenses as distributed. Carried
- 47. <u>Minnesota Public Drainage Manual Outreach Workshops</u>. A motion was made by Manager Hanson and seconded by Manager Askelson to approve staff and Manager attendance at the Minnesota Public Drainage Manual Outreach Workshop to be held on May 22 at Minnesota State Community and Technical College, Moorhead. Carried.
